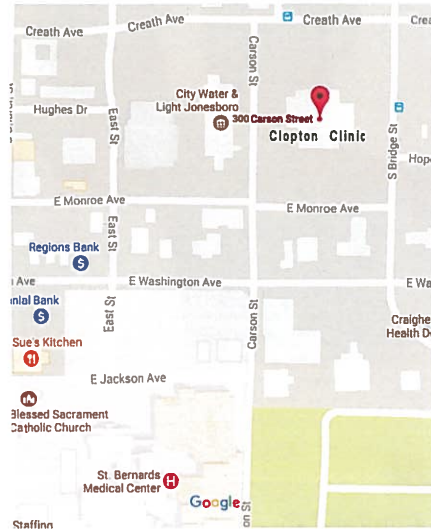

HOW IT WORKS
