Resolution in support of Arkansas State University Student Government Association to support the placement of a traffic light on the intersection of Aggie Road and Marion Berry Pkwy.

Short Title: A resolution calling the Arkansas State University Student Government Association to support the establishment of a traffic light on the intersection of Aggie Road and Marion Berry Pkwy.

- Whereas, the issue of congested traffic and safety concerns have been brought up to the Student Government Association towards this area, and
- Whereas, the SGA has consulted with UPD officers to recognize the need for this as a safety concern for all of Arkansas State students, staff and faculty members, and
- Whereas, ArDOT approved the placement of a traffic light in 2013 and traffic studies are still useful for the area based on report, and
- Whereas, the traffic light will allow students and drivers to safely drive and walk across the intersection in a timely manner.

The Student Government Association of Arkansas State University will support the establishment of the traffic light between Aggie Road and Marion Berry Pkwy.
