Whereas, the 1909 Society will give students about to graduate and/or leave for professional schools the chance to give back to ASU, and

Whereas, ASU currently does not have a place for students to leave their name on campus after graduation.


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

1. A giving society be established for students called the 1909 Society
2. The Student Alumni Chapter is given sole authority over all parts of the Society, including marketing, fund-raising, and recognition of the donors, along with any changes made as the Society evolves to best meet the needs of the students and the society.
3. The money raised will go into a 1909 Society Scholarship fund, to be distributed after endowment is met based on qualifications set by the ASU Foundation.
4. Students who become members of the 1909 Society will have their name permanently etched in a plaque that will be placed on the South end of the outside entrance to the Student Union.
