### **Resolution for Arkansas State University to create a Ticket to Table Program**

---

Short Title: A resolution to create a Ticket to Table Program partnered with Volunteer A-State and Parking Services that allows students to donate to the food pantry to receive credit for their parking tickets.

- Whereas, it is the Student Government Association's (SGA) job to make sure all students are satisfied with their experiences at Arkansas State University, and
- Whereas, there has been recent concerns amongst students with the current parking reprimands, and
- Whereas, there is always a need on Arkansas State University's campus to fill the Volunteer A-State Food Pantry, and
- Whereas, the Ticket to Table Program allows students to receive a \$25 credit towards their parking ticket account, and
- Whereas, once students finish the application made by SGA, they will then be notified by SGA to determine what is in need at that time in the A-State Food Pantry, and
- Whereas, the amount of food that will need to be donated will not exceed seven pounds which will be decided on by SGA and Volunteer A-State, and

Whereas, once it is determined the correct food items and amount have been given to the food pantry, then the students' information will be sent to Parking Services where the \$25 credit will be added to the citation, and

Whereas, the money for this initiative will be a \$5,000 cap allocation per semester and added to the Special Assistance section of the budget starting in the spring semester of the 2024-2025 school year.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF  
ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY THAT:

The Student Government Association will begin the Ticket to Table program in the Spring Semester of the 2024, 2025 academic year to give students the opportunity to have a \$25 credit to a citation and pack the A-State Food Pantry.
