Resolution to solve the parking problem that hinders the Arkansas State University ROTC members

Short Title: A resolution to allow Cadets and Cadres to park at the Military Science Building during the designated restricted parking hours.

- Whereas, Arkansas State University prides itself on its ability to work with military members; and
- Whereas, currently, Cadets and Cadre are not allowed to park at the Military Science Building lot during designated restricted parking hours; and
- Whereas, Cadets and Cadre are required to attend early morning training, and carry up to ninety pounds of gear, while also being encouraged to stay in the ROTC Living Learning Community; and
- Whereas, currently, Cadets and Cadre are fined and ticketed for parking in the Military Science Building lot; and
- Whereas, this parking problem has been a burden on Cadets and Cadre for years; and
- Whereas, a solution in the form of a parking permit allowance for ROTC members shall be implemented to allow ROTC members to park in the Military Science Building lot; and
- Whereas, fundraising on behalf of the ROTC members shall pay for the aforementioned parking permits in full.
