In most cases, general education courses may be interchanged between semesters. A minimum of 45 hours of upper-level credit (3000-4000 level) is required for this degree.

## Additional Graduation Requirements for BSA, concentration in Agricultural Education:

- 1. 2.70 GPA in **Major**, to be admitted to the College of Education Teacher Education program.
- 2. 2.70 **Cumulative** GPA, to be admitted to the College of Education Teacher Education program.
- 3. 120 total credit hours required
- 4. Minimum of 45 JR/SR Hours after completing 30 hours
- 5. 18 of last 24 hours must be from ASU-Jonesboro courses
- 6. Minimum of 57 hours from 4-year institutions
- 7. Minimum of 32 Resident Hours if completing second degree & first degree not from ASU-J
- 8. Maximum of 31 hours via correspondence, extension, examination, PLA, Military or similar means
- 9. 30 hours maximum CLEP
