Additional Graduation Requirements for BSA, concentration in Agricultural Education:

1. 2.70 GPA in **Major**, to be admitted to the College of Education Teacher Education program.
2. 2.70 **Cumulative** GPA, to be admitted to the College of Education Teacher Education program.
3. 120 total credit hours required
4. Minimum of 45 JR/SR Hours after **completing 30 hours**
5. 18 of last 24 hours must be from ASU-Jonesboro courses
6. Minimum of 57 hours from 4-year institutions
7. Minimum of 32 Resident Hours if completing second degree & first degree not from ASU-J
8. Maximum of 31 hours via correspondence, extension, examination, PLA, Military or similar means
9. 30 hours maximum CLEP
