

Master of Science Nutrition & Dietetics (RD Track)

Fall 1 – 2025 Start

Application deadline: 02/17/25

- Students are notified of acceptance on or before March 1, 2025.
 - Needed for acceptance:
 - Lifecycle nutrition, nutritional biochemistry, nutrition assessment, food science, nutrition counseling, community nutrition, medical nutrition therapy, and an applied statistics course (junior level or higher) – These courses may require up to 30 hours of prerequisites.
 - Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher – on all work
 - Personal statement
 - Two letters of recommendation
- Students must notify the program of their acceptance/denial of their spot in the program by March 15, 2025.
- March 15, 2025 – August 2025: Students have this time to prepare.
- Student registration deadline: July 1, 2025
 - Needed to begin classes:
 - Preceptor contacts for supervised practice due May 27, 2025
 - All documentation is due in Typhon: <https://www.typhongroup.net/> (This site requires a one-time fee of \$100) – We use this site for all documentation and practicum related information.
 - Medical documentation: due July 1, 2025 (Except TB & Flu)
 - TB Skin test – Only good for 1 year - Not needed until practicums begin in fall 2025
 - Flu Shot – Only good for 1 year - Not needed until practicums begin in fall 2025
 - Hepatitis B – 3 shot series
 - MMR
 - Tetanus – Must be from within the last 10 years
 - Other documentation: due July 1, 2025
 - CPR certification: Students are required to complete an American Heart Association (AHA) BLS Course: <https://cpr.heart.org/en/course-catalog-search>
 - ServSafe certification: <https://www.servsafe.com/>
 - Liability insurance: <https://www.proliability.com/>- Not needed until practicums begin in fall 2025
 - Auto insurance
 - Medical insurance

 - Background check – Must be less than 6 months old
