Novice Teacher Survey Data – Perceptions of Preparation

Data from the Novice Teacher Surveys are generated by the Arkansas Department of Education (ADE). First-year teachers complete a Novice Teacher Survey at the end of their first year of teaching to identify perceptions of their educator preparation experience based on the four TESS “Framework for Teaching” domains. The results for 2020, 2021 and 2022 are presented below. This data was gathered by Michael K. Rowland, Educator Preparation Program Advisor, at the Arkansas Department of Education.

Respondents were asked to rate the statements based on how well they felt their EPP prepared them in each category for their first year of teaching. **Scale: 1= Not prepared in this area 2= Minimally prepared 3= Adequately prepared 4= Well prepared**
