Subject: Honors Committee

The Honors Committee is composed of one faculty member representing each of the departments within the College of Education and Behavioral Science, which offer undergraduate degree programs. Members are appointed by the respective chairs from the departments and the committee elects its own chair. Terms are for two years.

The committee serves as an integral part of the university honors program. Its duties are to foster the College's participation in the honors program by encouraging faculty to offer honors courses (or an honors option for regularly scheduled courses) and to encourage qualified students within the College to enroll in the university honors program.

The committee chair serves as representative on University Honors Committee.
