

COOPER-HUITT MEMORIAL HISTORY SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Nature and Purpose of the Award. The Cooper-Huitt Memorial History Scholarship was established by the Department of History in 1977 in honor of Homer C. Huitt (1935-1965) and Durward F. Cooper (1946-1972) for their services to Arkansas State University. The purpose of this scholarship is to reward outstanding academic achievement in the field of history or social science education.

Amount and Term of the Award. One academic year (Fall and Spring semesters). Stipend will depend on current fund balance.

Eligibility. To be eligible for this scholarship, students must satisfy the following requirements:

1. Be classified as a History or Social Science major.
2. Have completed by the start of the scholarship semester at least 60 credit hours toward a degree, 27 of which must have been earned on the ASU-Jonesboro campus.
3. Have at least a 3.25 overall grade point average.

Application. Students must make a formal application for the scholarship and include with their application a full college transcript and the names of at least two faculty members of the History Department who have agreed to recommend them. Applicants may be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee.

Application forms are available in the office of the History Department, HSS Building 4007, Arkansas State University.
